

The nearest and most convenient station to go to Tokai University Kokusai Yuko Kaikan is "Hadano" of ODAKYU Electric Railway.

"Tokai Daigaku Mae" is the nearest station to Tokai Univ., and "Hadano" is the next stop of "Tokai Daigaku Mae".

From Narita airport to "Hadano", you can use trains.

There are 2 routes as follows.

1. Narita airport ---> Shinjuku ---> Hadano

Narita airport ---> Shinjuku by Narita Express which is the rapid train of JR East.

Shinjuku -----> Hadano by ODAKYU Electric Railway

2. Narita airport----> Nippori or Ueno----> Shinjuku ----> Hadano

Narita airport ---> Nippori or Ueno by Skyliner which is the airport express train of KEISEI Electric Railway.

Nippori is the one stop before last stop, UENO, by Skyliner

Nippori or Ueno ---> Shinjuku by Yamanote Line of JR East.

Shinjuku -----> Hadano by ODAKYU Electric Railway, this part is the same as the route No. 1.

In the case of Route 1 you can change a train just 1 time at Shinjuku station.

You should exchange a train twice in the case of route 2, but the fare of Route 2 is cheaper than that of route 1.

Route 1: 3,110 yen for Narita Express from Narita airport to Shinjuku

650 yen for ODAKYU Electric Railway from Shinjuku to Hadano

Route 2: 2,400 yen for Skyliner from Narita airport to Nippori

190 yen for Yamanote Line of JR East from Nippori to Shinjuku

650 yen for ODAKYU Electric Railway from Shinjuku to Hadano

If you don't have any confidence in changing a train twice you had better take route No.1 even the total fare is a bit expensive.

From Hadano station:

You can take a bus to go to Tokai University Kokusai Yuko Kaikan.

Nearest bus stop seems to be "Hadano-ko-mae".

"Hadano-ko-mae" means "the front of Hadano high school".
